- 1. Read Proverbs 8:1-5. What point is being made by the picture of wisdom standing in the most frequently traveled places calling? To whom is her call directed? What does she offer?
- 2. Read 8:6-9. There is a clear distinct between what wisdom has to say and what she detests. What characterizes wisdom's speech? What is anathema to her? Who understands that her words are right and faultless?
- 3. Read 8:10-11. If our choice is between wisdom and earthly wealth, what should we choose? Why?
- 4. Read 8:12-21. What accompanies wisdom (12, 14, 20)?
- 5. What will wisdom teach a wise person to hate (8:13)?
- 6. What is wisdom's role in good government (8:15-16)?
- 7. Will the person who seeks wisdom be disappointed (8:17)? Compare this to Jesus' words in Matthew 7:7. What does this tell us about God?
- 8. What does wisdom bring with her (8:18)?
- 9. Read 8:24-31. Note the artistry with which the creation of the world is described. Where was wisdom at creation? What was wisdom's function (8:3)?
- 10. What filled wisdom with delight (8:30-31?)
